- I. **General Awareness**:- Current Events of National and International Importance, Games and Sports, Art, and Culture of India, Indian Literature, Monuments and Places of India, General Science and Life Science (up to 10th std.), History of India and Freedom Struggle, Physical, Social and Economic Geography of India and World, Indian Polity and Governance- constitution and political system, General Scientific and Technological Developments including Space and Nuclear Program of India, UN and Other important World Organizations, Environmental Issues Concerning India and World at Large, Basics of Computers and Computer Applications, Common Abbreviations.
